Northfield Township is now requesting a lump sum payment of \$10,000.00 HLC Trustees are going to offer \$5,000.00 for all vacant land lots owned by Northfield Twp. A new member vote will have to take place, to approve a one-time cash payment. Per Treasurer, HLC does have the \$5,000.00 on hand to pay for properties. Joe Bennet motions to allow, Scott Chisholm, Brian Trim, and George Brown to negotiate a new price for the vacant land, Mike Grosh seconds. Motion passes. All in favor. Northfield Twp initially paid \$8,000 for the vacant land.

HLC task Tracker- Makenzie. A wooded lot in Leocadia park, has a tree problem. Ken Johnson is going to assess the problem. Brian Trim says a cherry picker is needed to solve problems. New Gravel is needed in Leocadia, specifically at Oliver Street.

Landscaping contractor approval, Mike Laird. Notice for bids was posted on HLC, between March 3 and March 14. Only one completed bid was received. WB Lawn Masters submitted a bid. His bid was \$185.00 to \$195.00 per cut. Price spread is depending upon services requested, on all 10 properties. Full service of cut, weed whipped, and blown off, is full price of \$195.00 per cut. WB Lawn Masters was the contractor used last year. Last year, 21 total cuts over the course of the year, resulting in \$3,900.00 for the season. WB Lawn masters. 517-672-9714. Hartland MI.
